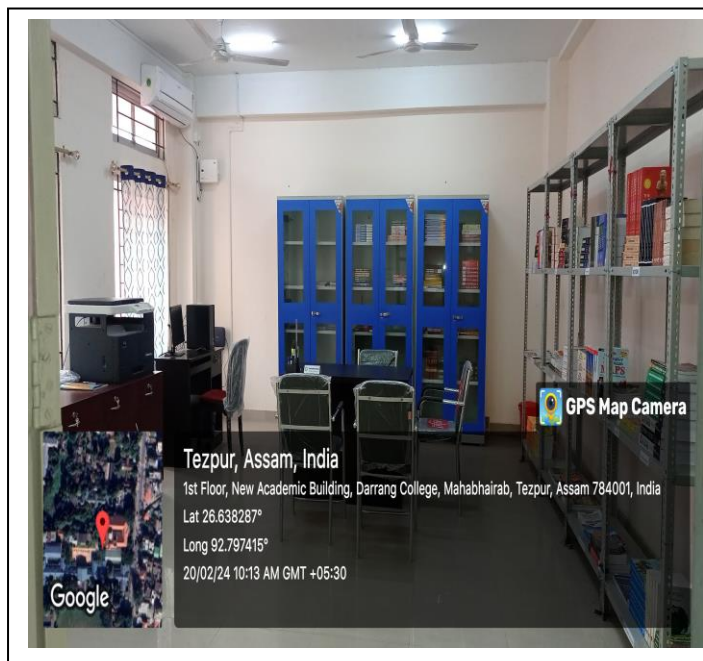
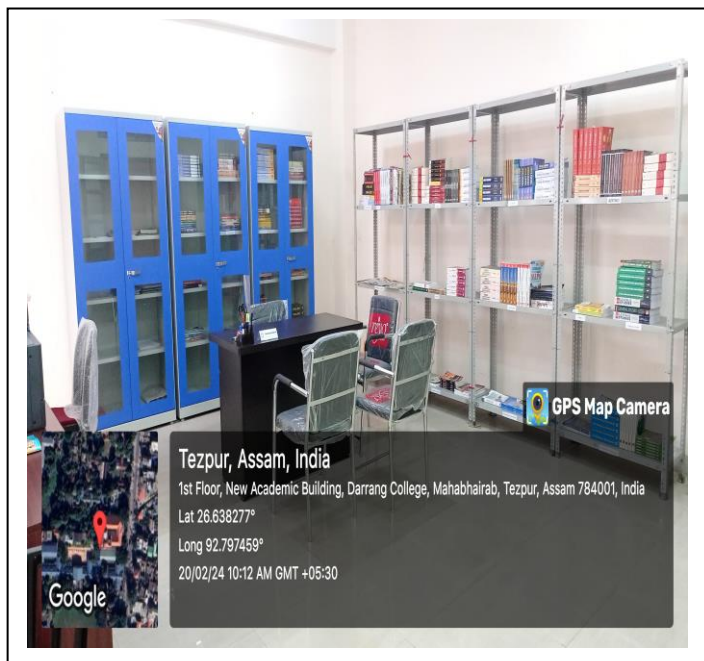
1) Infrastructure

The CSSC, D.C today boasts of its own full fledged establishment consisting of a Library cum Office, a Reading Room, and a Conference Hall. The furniture and stationery etc have been procured through tender.



2) Books

The CSSC library today has a good collection of books for Competitive Exams. The total Number of books currently is 277.



3) Personnel

The CSSC is open for students on all week days, and the Center is run day to day by a college appointed employee.

4) Enrollment

As many as 174 numbers of students have registered themselves at the Center, and are availing of the library and reading room facilities.
